Building new homes

We are pleased to have appointed a contractor, Halsall, to start construction of new homes on the estate. Halsall is an experienced construction company who have worked on several development projects across the South West.

We are now in the process of finalising the contract with Halsall for the building of a block of 28 new apartments at the entrance to Talbot Gardens. These homes will be the first to be built through this project which will mark a huge milestone for the community.

You are likely to see some activity on site in the coming weeks as contractors begin preparing the land for construction. Building of the new homes is set to start later in the year.

We will provide more details on exact dates once these are confirmed.

Demolition update

You will have seen that blocks five and six, on Talbot Gardens and Roope Hill Close, are now empty and secure. We have appointed a contractor to demolish the buildings and work will start on this in the coming weeks. We will notify you once we have an exact date for the work to commence.

We are also in the process of securing vacant possession of blocks seven and eight on Savage Road. Once confirmed, we will be able to plan demolition of these empty buildings.
