Planning permission granted to Swan for the regeneration of Laindon town centre to create new homes, a new high street, and an expanded new health centre. Regeneration paused as two new planning applications were needed – one to make changes to

The project was further stalled after Swan encountered financial difficulties. Sanctuary took over Swan.

the highways design required by Essex County Council and the other to change the building method for the homes to meet updated building regulations.

Sanctuary is now working with Swan to deliver the regeneration and create a new town centre.

Since our community event in July, we have been using the feedback from over 500 local people to develop detailed plans that meet community needs and remove unnecessary build costs, so the project is financially viable.

We're pleased to be able to share these updated plans with you today and we'd love to hear what you think.





The scheme we build will include:

- Iocal shops including a new Lidl and new shop units for local retailers.
- > an option for an improved medical centre.

The scheme we build won't increase the heights of the scheme beyond existing planning permission and will have fewer homes than currently approved. It may include less or a small number more.

- > a fitting setting for your war memorial and historic Laindon fountain.
- > managed parking.









Proposed plans - overview

We have listened to your feedback and the new scheme will include 15 local shops plus a new Lidl, a Sanctuary office, managed parking, public spaces to house your war memorial and fountain, as well as new highquality homes with parking.

Thank you for sharing your feedback on what you'd like to see in the scheme. A lot of people said the same things and we have taken your feedback into account in creating our proposed plans.





"We need more affordable houses for local families."

"We want these homes to have car parking." The scheme will provide new, highquality affordable flats and houses, with a mixture of social/affordable rent and Shared Ownership available. There will be one parking space per flat and two parking spaces per house. Visitor parking will also be provided.

"We don't want skyscrapers. They're unsightly" The scheme isn't any taller than Swan's previously approved planning permission.

"We need local shops as we're having to go outside Laindon to do our shopping, which is expensive."

"We've been left without local services for a long time." There will be retail space for 15 new local shops (including Templeman Opticians and Well Pharmacy) as well as a larger Lidl.

We're confident that the remaining

shop units will attract a variety of new businesses, providing the local community with much-needed local services.

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"We want parking that is close to Lidl and the other shops."

"This needs to be managed so that people can't use it for commuting." There'll parking spaces near the shops, including disabled bays. The parking will be monitored to ensure it isn't misused by commuters.

"Our war memorial is important as it honours local heroes. It needs to be in an accessible public area."

"Make sure you keep our fountain and war memorial as these are important to local people."

The scheme will put the war memorial and historic Laindon fountain at its heart.

"We'd like some sort of shared outdoor space."

A well-managed urban park with grass, trees and benches will create a hub for local people.

WILL YOU HAVE TO DEMOLISH ANY OF THE STRUCTURES CURRENTLY ON SITE?

We're consulting with Building Control on this. The plans may require the demolition of some constructed stair cores. Otherwise, we can use the existing structure to deliver the scheme. This will make the scheme faster and financially viable to complete.



A local shopping hub

The proposed plans for the new homes are for a fully affordable scheme that will meet local housing and community need:



Support for local businesses wanting to locate in the new shopping hub.

The shops will be designed to have a similar look and

feel to create a sense of unity in the design.



High quality public spaces

The scheme will put your war memorial and historic Laindon fountain at its heart.



Improved public lighting, new paving and street furniture such as benches will create a safe, accessible, and attractive shared space for people to live, work and shop.





A well-managed urban park with grass, trees and benches will create a hub for local people. The park will be positioned on top of the podium, between the flats and houses.

> A mixture of planting to enhance the green space and increase biodiversity.





New Homes

The proposed plans for the new homes are for a fully affordable scheme that will meet local housing and community need:



205 new, high-quality affordable homes (210 homes in previous Swan planning consent).

> Approximately 50% social and affordable rent, 50% affordable ownership (a significant increase in affordable homes compared to previous Swan planning consent).





The buildings will not be any taller than the previous Swan planning consent.



Parking will be provided beside the houses that are positioned on top of the podium.


We've reduced the amount of cladding and introduced more brick to make the buildings look more traditional, in keeping with your local area.

- > The main scheme will require a new planning application. We will use the feedback you give us on the proposed plans that we have shown you today to create final plans for the scheme. We will then submit a new planning application by winter 2024.
- > In the meantime, we will start work! You will first see us working on the highways, starting in **December 2023** so Lidl can begin building its new store.
